To put some light in their challenges our students took the opportunity to conduct a telephonic interview of Mr. Rajendra Nikalji (Police Inspector) Pimpri who spoke about their current situation.

Q Interviewer - Sir, we have seen in this critical situation the general public has been a challenge to manage. Can you share your thoughts?

Mr. Rajendra Nikalji - We are doing our duty and nothing stops us from helping the people in making them understand how to stay safe. It becomes our responsibility in making people understand that we are supporting the general public with a cause. Their support and patience is our strength.

Q Interviewer - Sir, it is very disheartening to see and hear that many policemen have to sacrifice their lives in their line of duty. What steps are being taken for the safety and security of the police force?

Mr. Rajendra Nikalji - Yes, it has been a tough phase for us, as indeed we have lost many good officers and constables doing their duty. We are trying to take necessary precautions and taking training as per the safety guidelines provided by the government.

Students of SNBP, Rahatani interviewed Dr. Mrs. Tonape to know her current role in this pandemic situation.

Q Avnish - Ma'am, kindly tell us the challenges faced as a doctor during this situation?

Dr Tonape - As it's an un-researched new virus, there have been no studies available about the pathophysiology & treatment. Unavailability of adequate protective gear, trained staff, isolation wards and infra-structures, lack of ICU facilities and most importantly it was the lack of empathy towards doctors which are some of the major challenges faced by us.

Q Avnish - How do you create a balance between the personal and professional life?

Dr Tonape - It is very difficult for the entire medical staff. All health care workers have to be very cautious. They need to maintain a distance for weeks from their loved ones after working in the wards. This definitely is worrisome for the family back home too.

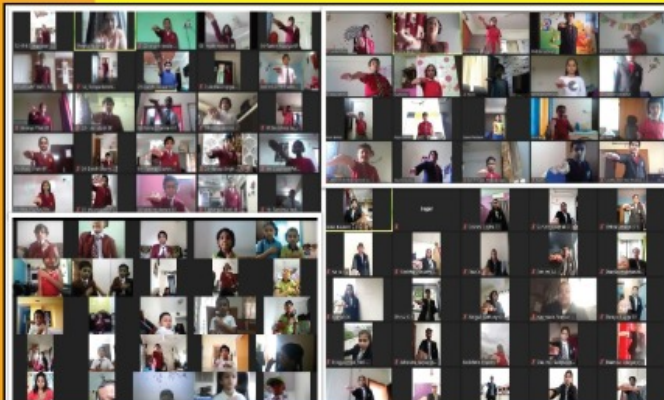
Q Avnish - What are the do's and don'ts that one should follow?

Dr Tonape - Please follow all the instructions given by the government time to

time. Some basic - rules of lockdown, wear a mask, frequently wash your hands with soap and water, eat healthy & nutritious food and drink warm water and the most important one is maintain distance.

Q Avnish - What message would you like to give the general public?
